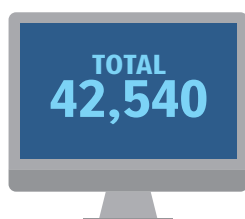

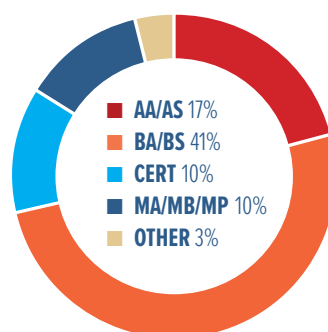

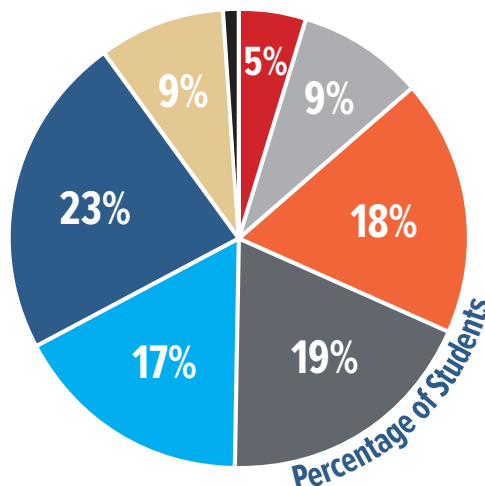

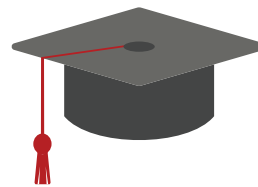
## AVERAGE STUDENT RETENTION

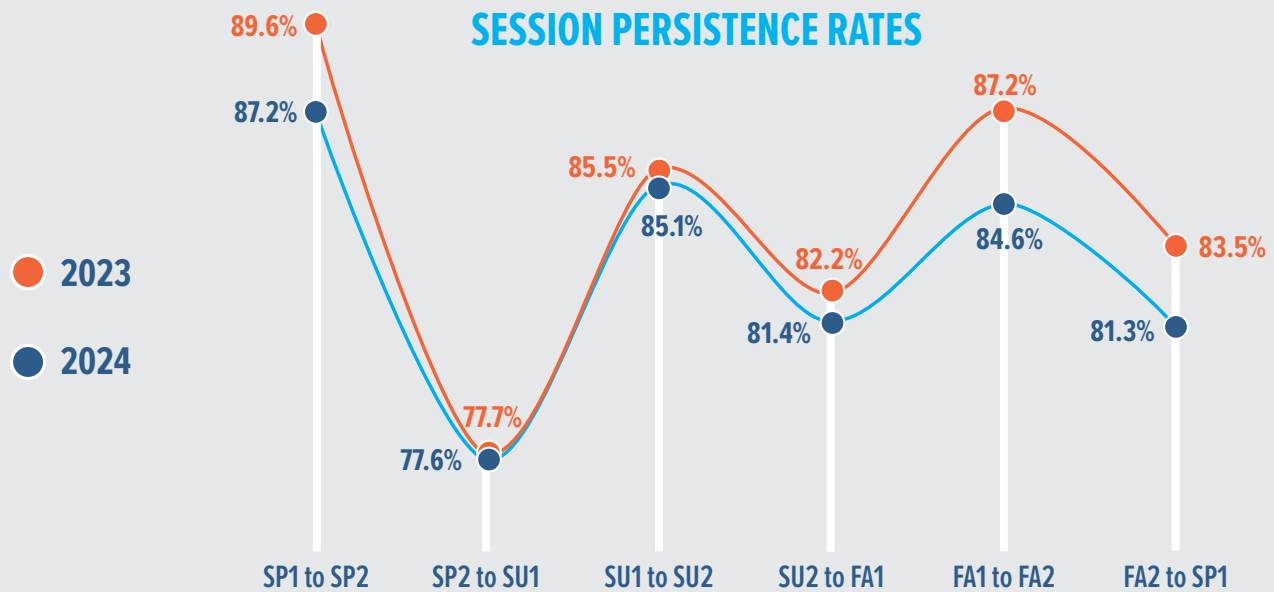

## SESSION PERSISTENCE RATES



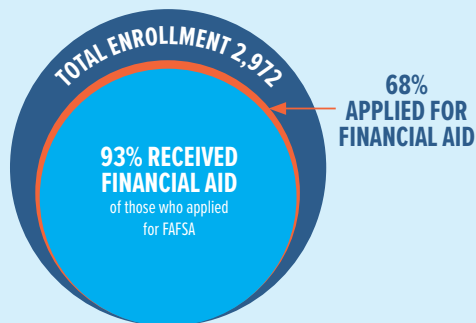

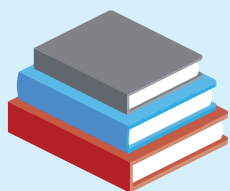
