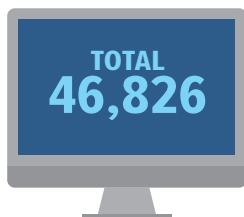

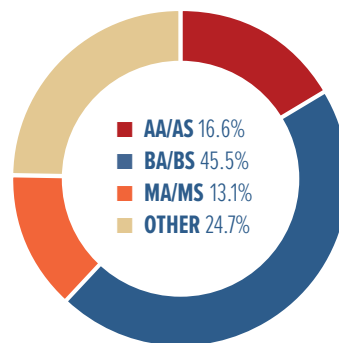

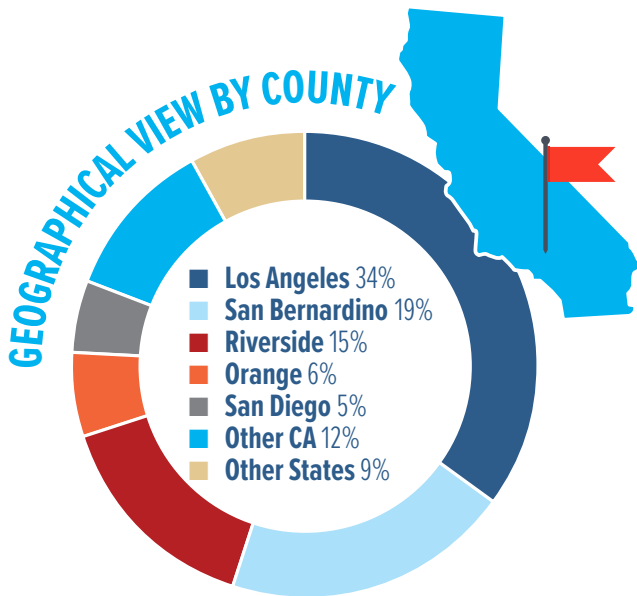

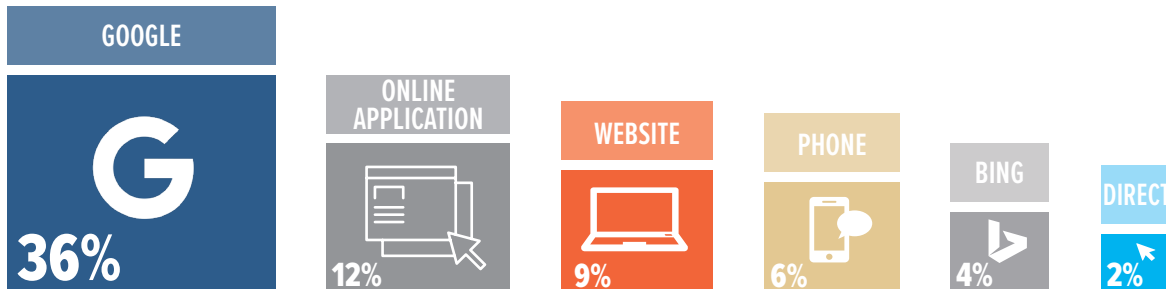

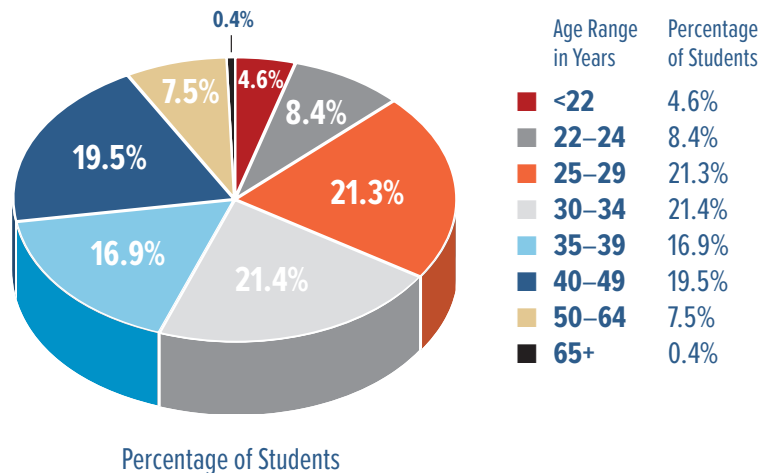

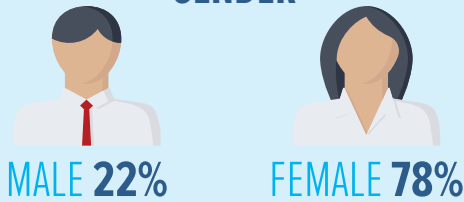

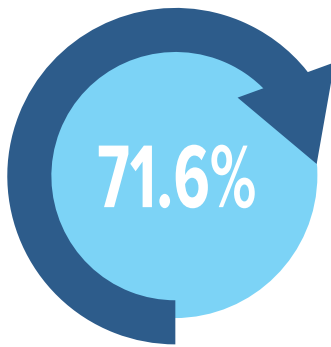

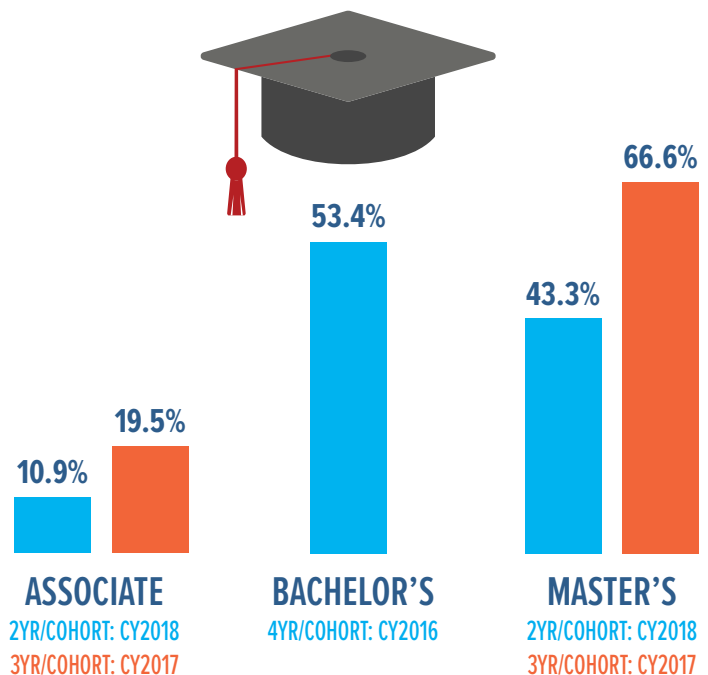
## AVERAGE STUDENT RETENTION

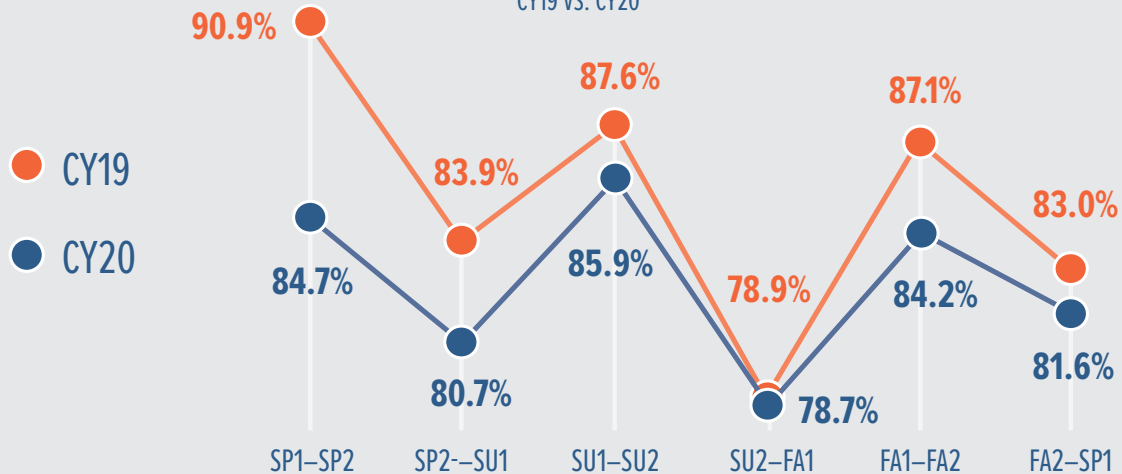

CY19 VS. CY20



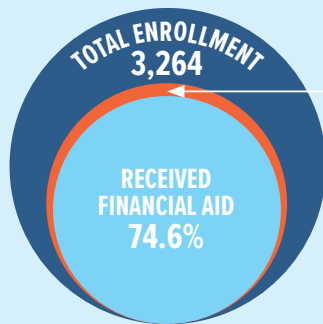

AMONG 4-YEAR, PRIVATE NOT-FOR-PROFIT UNIVERSITIES IN CALIFORNIA\*



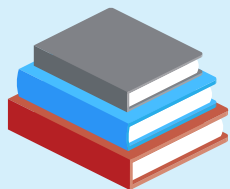
