Evidence	<p>PLO 5: Examine cultural and diversity issues within the field of psychology</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. There is currently no sample size for APSY 520. It is a new course that has been developed and just launched in Fall 1 2019. <p>The PLO artifact was previously embedded in APSY 690, which was determined to be an unsuitable course (it was too vague, ambiguous, flexible) to assess the PLO. The PLO was reassigned to APSY 520.</p> <p>PLO 6: Apply theories, skills, and knowledge within the field of psychology</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. There is currently no sample size for APSY 510. It is being revamped and will be relaunched for Summer 2 2020. The PLO artifact is staying in APSY 510, but the assignment and course itself was determined to be inadequate as a means to assess the PLO, thus the course revision. <p>A review of the courses by Dr. Oh and Dr. Kao determined that course revisions were required, and they began course revision without waiting for a formal PLO assessment to show inadequacies in measuring for the PLO.</p> <p>Dr. Christine Oh, Assistant Dean, determined that because there is no sample size for both PLOs, they need to be revisited in the future once the courses (APSY 520 and 510) have run/launched.</p> <p>It is her recommendation to assess PLOs 1 and 2 for 2020, so there is time to establish sample sizes in the courses used to measure for PLOs 5 and 6.</p> <p>PLOs 5 and 6 can be assessed for the year after in 2021, and PLOs 3 and 4 in 2022.</p>
