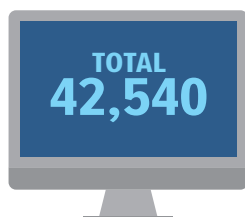

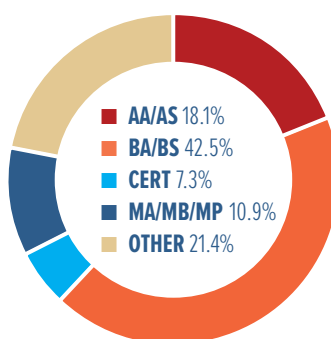

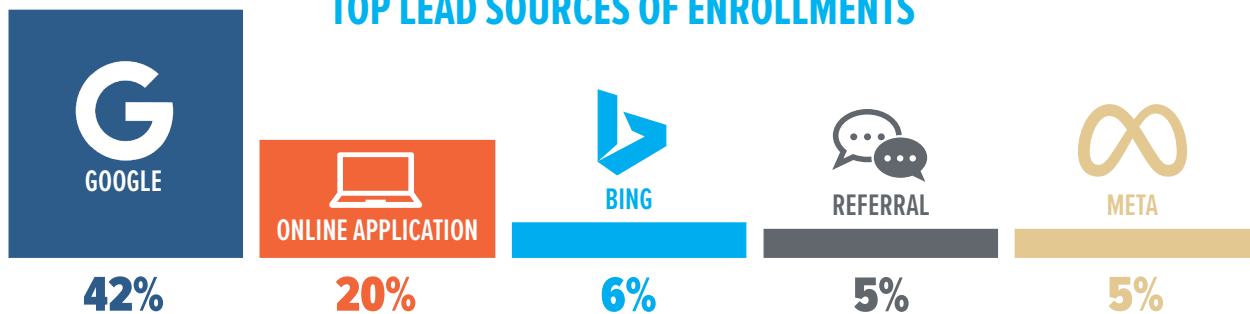

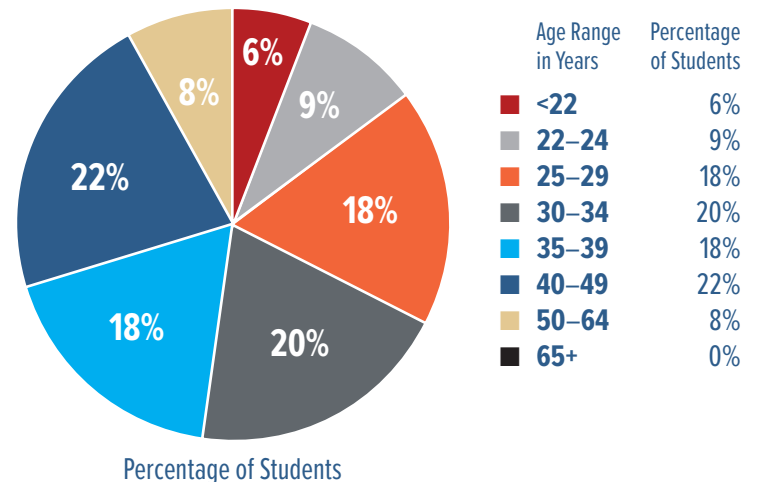

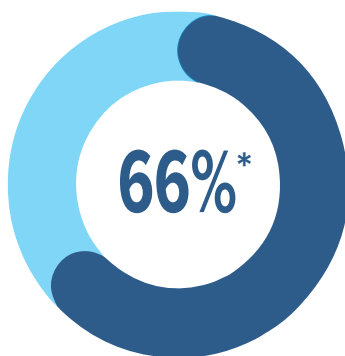

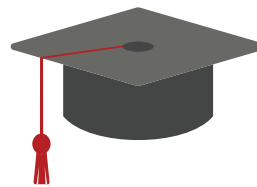
AVERAGE STUDENT RETENTION

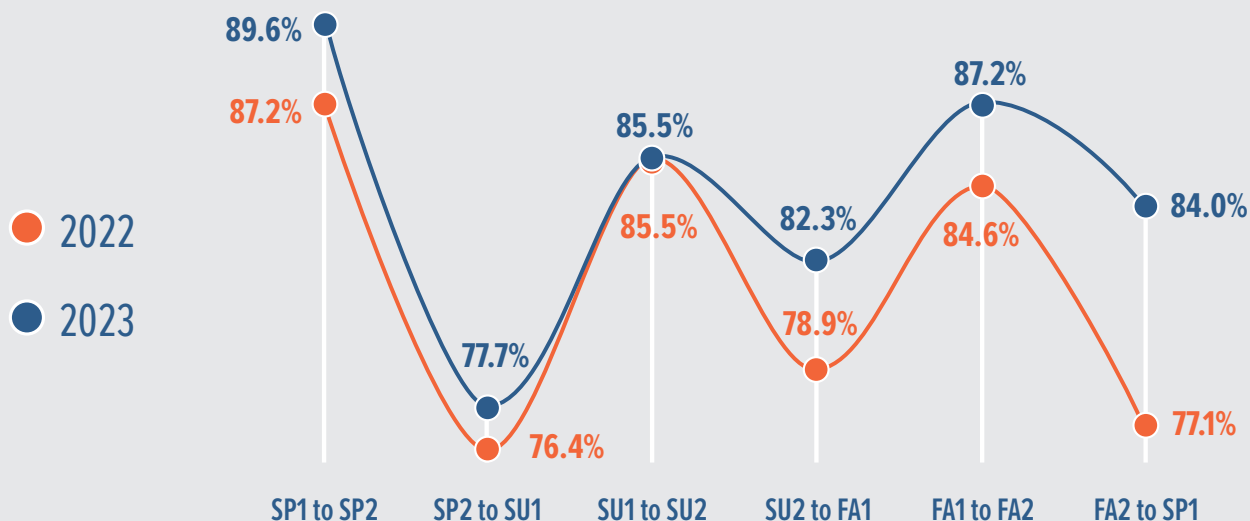

SESSION PERSISTENCE RATES



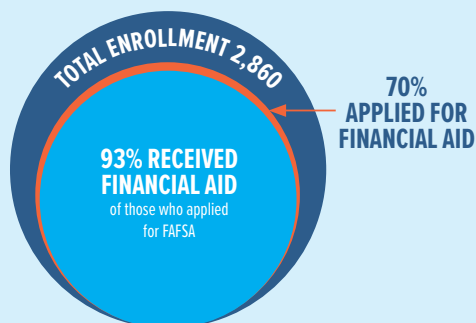

AMONG 4-YEAR, PRIVATE NOT-FOR-PROFIT UNIVERSITIES IN CALIFORNIA*

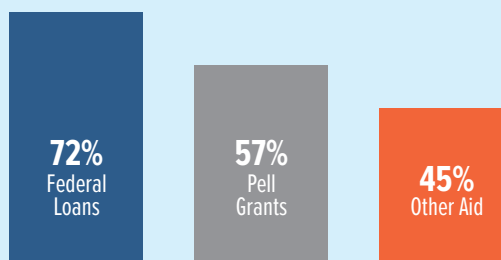
